Academic Updates

Attendance Reminder

Consistent attendance is one of the strongest predictors of academic success. Please remind your child that being present—and being on time—matters. If your student will be absent, remember to send an excuse (written, email, or phone call) within three days.

New directives from the state of Pennsylvania:

When a family is calling their student off from school to please report the reason as to why they are off. For example if it is due to respiratory illness

diagnosis such as COVID, RSV, or Influenza and/or symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, runny/stuffy nose, body aches, and feeling very tired.

Virtual Instruction Days Information

STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BE LOGGED INTO THEIR SCHOOL GOOGLE ACCOUNT IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES

On the day of cancellation and implementation of a Virtual Instruction day, the student will also receive an email reminder about the expectations. Their Schoology accounts will also be used to do all of their work and there is also a link there for them to do attendance for the day.

Attendance

- Students will learn from home
- Student daily attendance will be accomplished by the student completing a [Google form for](#) attendance by **10:00 AM** that has been emailed to each student and is also posted in the period 1 Schoology course.
- If you do not have Internet access, you must call the school to confirm student attendance (814) 773-3164.
- Student class period attendance will be entered in Schoology by the classroom teacher based on assignment completion.

Student Expectations

- Virtual Instruction Days will be **asynchronous**. This means students will not be expected to login during scheduled class time, but they are expected to complete the work at their own pace. Teachers will be available by email if you need assistance.
- The teacher will publish a VID assignment folder for students to complete in each Schoology class.
- Students should access their classes in Schoology based on their MAROON/WHITE day schedule for the day. In other words, if a VID day falls on a MAROON day, students will complete work for classes they would normally have on a MAROON day.
- Student work is expected to be completed on this day or based on the teacher-identified timeline. If the work is not completed for any reason, the completion date will follow the teacher's classroom policy for absent work.
- If a student experiences difficulty on an assignment or lacks accessibility to Schoology due to technical issues, they are to reach out to their teacher during the scheduled teacher time via email.
